Research problem:

The theory of economics and management still does not keep pace with the dynamic development of economy. Based on well-known theories, many different problems cannot be solved, such as the limitation of the anthropogenic biosphere load or the income stratification in various societies. It is necessary to search for a new paradigm of socio-economic development, and thus certain revision of existing theoretical assumptions and axioms. Such problems can be primarily solved in the context of teamwork.

The purpose of the conference will be:

- to improve the ability to build effective research teams and work organization with the use of the latest design methods.

Applications – by August 30, 2017

Suggestions for presentations (the program is general; the organizers encourage the submission of papers – one page of a typescript with an indication of a purpose and main theses) – by 15 August 2017.

It is planned to publish the submitted texts in a peer-reviewed scientific monograph.
